





Deployment of the IUT2 ePortfolio

2 types of pedagogical approaches

Personal and Professional Development (PPP) course

cross-cutting course, 40 teachers into 29 programs.

Students:

- Reflect on the skills they have acquired.
- Self-evaluate, ask for evaluation
- Identify their most-valued skills.
- Compare their most-valued skills to the skills required by 200 different careers.
- Create a CV and a personal interactive bubble map with evidence for recruiters

Collaborative Web 2.0 course

1st pilot disciplinary course, 1 program, LMS + KIUT ePortfolio

Students:

- Reflect on the skills they have acquired during course
- Self-evaluate and ask teacher for evaluation of skills.
- Reflect on the benefit of these skills for their PPP






Students select a repository and choose the skills to add.







Assessment of the IUT2 ePortfolio Project

- Seven-year institutional transformation.
- Facilitating the professional development of the 3000 IUT2 students that use it.
- Essential tool for use by the Center for Skills and Careers (CCM) with the PPP course
- Supported by 40 instructors in PPP cross domain hybrid course
- National and Regional projects with Teaching & Learning LAB and CCM to promote the KIUT ePortfolio for use at other French academic institutions.

Evolution in progress of the Karuta application created by IUT2 now under consideration by numerous French universities.

Recruit competent and motivated talent with different companies writing job offers differently for the same profession.




Students, graduates...

Brick 1: My Professional Profile




Using a questionnaire, students discover their professional potential

along with a list of possible activities to motivate them to engage professionally.

They then build their own professional profiles.

The "Intelligent" ENP

Brick 2: My career map and possible employment opportunities




Students identify careers that most closely match their professional profile

and employment opportunities related to these careers within their region.

Brick 3: My education and training map




Students identify training paths that permit access to the careers they have discovered and selected

along with the skills associated with each career.

Brick 4: The universe of experiences and career paths within a community of peers
